Hike, practical

Departure 9.15 am - return around 4 pm.

From the Monastery there will be an approx. 30' -45' ride by minibus. Then a hike of 3h30 to 4h30 with frequent stops. Altitude variation : about 400 m.

Bring good comfortable walking shoes. We'll provide you with walking sticks, backpacks and a picnic.

A good physical condition is necessary.

At the entrance of the Gorges du Verdon, Aiguines offers a breathtaking view on the Lake Ste-Croix. A stroll around the winding streets of this typical Provençal village, with its fountains, church and an amazing castle. Ann will talk about the history of the « boules de pétanque », first manufactured in this village.

After a picnic on the lake border, we'll head towards Les Salles-sur-Verdon, 'one of Frances youngest villages'. You'll be taken around to discover the remains of the ancient valley, that has been submerged in the lake, after the construction of a dam.

# Towards Esparron, through landscapes in bloom

Then, across the plateau of Valensole where roses, lavender and sage are in full bloom this time of the year. You'll appreciate the unique landscape: golden wheat, blue lavender, turquoise water...
