HIKE IN THE VERDON REGION

Saturday 13th April, 25th May, 8th June, 13th and 27th July, 7th September 2019



Your guide, Philippe Maïda



Philippe, mountain guide, will take you on various hiking-trails in Haute-Provence : from the majestic Verdon to the grasslands of the Pre-Alps. You'll experience a "bowl of fresh air" during a walk of about 4 hours with stops to enjoy every moment and to picnic.

You'll be pleasantly surprised by the stories and anecdotes all through the walk.

Even though you need to be in good physical shape, Philippe adapts the rythm of walks, depending on the group.

Exemples of the trails proposed :
- Les Gorges de Trévans
- Le massif du Montdenier
- Les Basses Gorges du Verdon à Quinson

The choice will be made taking into account the weather conditions and the group.



Hike, practical

Departure 9.15 am – return around 4 pm.

From the Monastery there will be an approx. 30' -45' ride by minibus. Then a hike of 3h30 to 4h30 with frequent stops. Altitude variation : about 400 m.

Bring good comfortable walking shoes. We'll provide you with walking sticks, backpacks and a picnic.

A good physical condition is necessary.

We reserve the right to cancel the excursion if the weather forecast is not favorable. In that case, we'll reimburse the supplement you paid.

EXCURSION CULTURE - NATURE



Anne Siaudeau, country guide, will help you discover some wonders of the region. Passionate about nature and culture, Anne will make you travel through time, taking you to magnificent places, sharing her knowledge and numerous anecdotes with you. She talks of the region in clear terms and explains about the flora, fauna and history of its villages.

« **Châteauneuf hier et aujourd'hui - Gorges du Verdon** »
13th April, 25th May, 8th June, 10th August and 21st September 2019

In the morning, Anne will take you for a walk towards Châteauneuf-les-Moustiers, through the awesome landscapes of the Southern Alps foothills. This ancient village was abandoned in the midst of the 20th Century.

The hike will help you better understand the life of the inhabitants of this village through the centuries, their work, their history, their customs, their happiness and woes, the reasons why the village was abandoned.

After a picnic, you'll visit the Gorges du Verdon, the biggest canyon in Europe, with breathtaking views.



Practical

Departure : 9.15 am – return around 5 pm.

From the Monastery there will be a 30 to 45' min. drive by minibus. Then a hike of 1h30 with frequent stops. Bring comfortable walking or sports shoes. We'll provide a picnic lunch. Minimum 4 and maximum 8 participants.

In case of bad weather conditions, we'll propose an adapted excursion.
